This week is bike week, which has been a tradition here at Channel for the last 30 years.

As I talked to a prospective parent during a 'walk and talk' the comment was made "Do you still do bike week?" He was a past student from Channel. This highlights the importance of building experiences with our students which have a life-long impact.

Learning by doing is known as "experiential learning" and is replacing chalk-and-talk pedagogy of the past with inquiry, problem-based and project-based learning. It teaches students to be engaged citizens.

At Channel we have the privilege of modelling our teaching methods on the greatest teacher of all – Jesus. He used this method of experiential learning when he taught His disciples, and the people He reached out to. Our aim is for all our students to learn with experiences that will help them discern and interpret experiences according to the standards of God's word.
