#### Athletics Carnival - 5 November

All students from Kinder to Year 6 will participate in our annual Athletics Carnival. The focus for the day is on each student striving to achieve their personal best using the gifts God has given them.

Children are slotted into 2 house teams, Adventure (Blue) and Discovery (Red), creating a healthy competition between them. On the day children will be provided with a coloured t-shirt, so that they are easily identified as a house team member. Children are expected to come in their sports uniform on the day.

The day will start at 10 am with the whole school track events. We start with the 100 metre race working down from year 6 through to Kinder. We then move to the 200 metres, 400 metres and relays.

When the children are not running in their event they will be cheering on their team. When all the running races are finished the children will have lunch around 11.30 - 12.00

After lunch the carnival splits into 2 parts. The Early Childhood children (K-Year 2) will participate in novelty events on the back oval, whilst the primary children (Year 3-6) will compete in the field events on the front oval.

Parents are always invited to come and watch, cheer and assist if needed.
